

Lovely Planet:

Starting from the flight in a hot air balloon over the Cappadocia region to the trip to Antarctica, to the snorkelling with turtles in Polynesia, six experiences worth the trip.

For all those who want to disconnect from the world and find themselves suddenly transported after a couple of hours in flight, then Cappadocia is the ideal destination - a historic region in Anatolia. Once outside the airport of Nevsehir, in the direction of Goreme, the surrounding landscape suddenly transforms into a lunar landscape: limestone formations and volcanic rock where underground cities come undone, monasteries dug in rock and the 'fairy walks', construction modelled by nature which hide in their name a fairy-tale character. The most evocative way to discover Cappadocia is definitely from the top of a hot air balloon; every day in fact at dawn dozen balloons rise into the sky. A unique experience to discover a unique land. Once back with one's feet on the ground, the emotional journey continues to Uchisar, one of the most fascinating villages of the Turkish region, where the resort Argos is located (part of Mytha Hotel Anthology which also counts the Capri Palace in its portfolio). At the bottom of a majestic castle 55 rooms were extracted from stone, of which 21 suites. The senses will be satisfied in the Anatolian restaurant or in the wine cellar with over 22 thousand wines, and in the Spa, between massages and a revisited Turkish bath. The best season to visit Cappadocia: in the winter with snow, it is even more fascinating.
