W H I T E T E A S

Silver Bud Ya Bao - China 12,00 €

An exceptionally high quality, rare tea from wild tea trees found in the winter months. The colours range from white-cream to green moss. Smooth aroma matched with a touch of spice and floral freshness. Its liquor is white gold in colour.

Sangri-La - Nepal 12,00 €

A splendid tea grown in the Ilam area of Nepal at an altitude of 1900m. In contrast to other white teas, this tea has a surprising texture with hints of citrus and fruits. Full-bodied with floral notes and aromas linger in the mouth. Colourful leaf strands with opulent silver tints. Especially for gourmets!

G R E E N T E A S

Lung Ching 1st Grade - China 10,00 €

Considered the “Champagne of tea”, with a long tradition in China, and one of the 10 most famous and flavourful Chinese teas Each tea leaf is flat, rigid but soft to touch and green-yellowish in color. Its liquor gives us a cup of pale yellow colors with orange reflections; it has a smooth taste with sweet and spicy tones. It has a lightweight body and almost no astringency.

Shi Bi Lo Chun - China 10,00 €

The highest quality Chinese tea. It is known as the “Green Spring Snail”. It has long, curly green leaves with silver specks and makes a beautiful amber coloured tea. Smooth, floral and fruity.
Perfection in a tea!

Organic Sincha Kagoshim - Japan 16,00 €

Limited edition from the first and only harvest of the year. The greeny-blueish, very fine leaves have a herbal aroma. “Shin” means new, so the name of the tea is actually “new tea”.
It has an emerald-green, rather opaque liquor. Full-bodied and astringent, this tea lingers on the palate with a final sweet taste.
A true pleasure to taste!

Organic Gyokuro - Japan 16,00 €

Only the most tender leaves from the first days of spring are used in this darker tea. The leaves are fine and silky, and greeny-blueish in colour.
Its liquor is intense pale green in color that sparkles, and has a naturally sweet aroma. High astringency.

Premiun Kukicha - Japan 12,00 €

Since this tea is produced from the stems of the Sencha plant, it has almost no theine. Kuki means “stems”. The playing of colours from the dry green, white and yellow herbs is delightful, and results in an almost opaque, intense green liquor.
A slightly spicy taste with a nutty finish, this tea has high astringency and lingers on the palate.

English Breakfast 10,00 €

Traditional mix of black teas from Sri Lanka and India.
Reddish-amber in color, this mix of teas has an intense aroma and is astringent on the palate. With a full and dry flavour strengthened by sweet and strong perfume with hints of malt and oak, it is perfect for adding milk and sugar.

Decaffeinated - Ceylon 10,00 €

An excellent theine-free black tea from Sri Lanka, it stands out for its reddish tones and its citric, fresh and intense taste.

I N F U S I O N S

New Expectations – Weight and cellulite reducing 9,00 €

An excellent combination of centella asiatica, silver birch, caraway, horsetail, pennyroyal mint, cardamom and calendula. Perfect for combating cellulite, excess weight and wrinkles. It also acts as a diuretic and a purifier, and has a minty taste with light bitter notes. It is also great as iced tea.

B L A C K T E A S

Darjeeling Namring Upper S.F.T.G.F.O.P.1 Clonal Special Exclusive - India 12,00 €

As lovers of tea would say, this is "Simply far too good for ordinary people". This "Grand Cru" has a fruity freshness typical of the Spring harvest. It gives a liquor of pale gold color, velvety, fresh, fruity at the beginning with subtle vegetable and floral notes.

Huang Di Pearls - China 12,00 €

A marvellous tea rolled into pearl shapes by hand. It has an amber-gold colored liquor with an exquisite and glamorous taste and a sweet yet spicy finish.

Himalayan Nepal - Nepal 12,00 €

Perfect silver specks throughout this tea's leaves give it its fine structure. Once infused, a clear yellow color filled with floral notes emerges, with a slight taste of grape, and a very special character.

Earl Grey Assam Golden Tippy 10,00 €

Originating from the first half of the 19th century, this tea was supposedly gifted to Earl Grey II. It is a mix of Indian black tea and the essence and pieces of bergamot. It has a citric and lightly sweet taste; to have with or without milk.

Jasmin Li Chung Hao - China 10,00 €

This divine floral tea from the Fujian province in China has specks of dark olive green. It produces a cup full of yellow-greenish color, light with a strong flavor of jasmine. It has a sweet finish that lingers on the palate, with white flower and gardenia notes. Perfect for lovers of jasmine!

Moroccan 10,00 €

Traditional tea from the Maghreb, this is an example of tea's globalization. This is a mix of Gunpowder tea from China, peppermint tea from Morocco and natural aromas. Yellowy-orange in color with a refreshing and minty aroma, it has an intense mint flavor and a silky texture, with the vegetal taste from the Gunpowder.

Y E L L O W T E A S

Gold Kekecha - China 10,00 €

In this golden tea, the perfect point of fermentation has been found. Due to its stimulating effect, experiencing this tea will always be a privilege for Buddhist monks, who discovered it in the Anhui region in China. It comes from a large, multi-coloured herb with bronze, gold and green tones. This gives it an iridescent liquor, giving prominence to the orangey-golden tones. This tea has a papaya touch to its taste, with spicy notes towards the end. Simply delicious!

D A R K T E A S

Gong Tin Pu Erh - China

12,00 €

Consumed exclusively by the Chinese nobility for hundreds of years, this tea comes from the Yunnan province, and in contrast to other teas, has been made from the leaves of ancient trees. It is known as “the devourer of fats”, and has little theine.

A magnificent tea, very regular, sprinkled with golden buds, with a liquor of delicate astringency and aromas of damp earth, roots of beet and mushrooms, sweet flavor that gives this tea a very good character.

Sheng Puerh - China

10,00 €

Also known as “Raw Puerh”, in contrast to the Shou Puerh, this tea is naturally fermented by the passing of years, which maintains the leaves’ dark green color and their white and brown hints.

It has a yellow liquor with a pinkish edge that gives a light aroma of chestnuts with a slightly stronger taste than green teas.

The Godesses Ritual

10,00 €

This tea is made from a mixture of first-grade Puerh, cocoa shells, chopped mint, rose hip, poppy petals and pomegranate flower. A delicate and ceremonial blend with sweet spicy notes, which satisfies your sweet tooth without the sensation of guilt. It'll soon turn into your own ritual!

O O L O N G T E A S

Qing Tie Guan Yin - China

14,00 €

Meaning “the Chinese Goddess of Mercy”, this tea is produced in Anxi in Fujian into small balls that once infused, reveal a big open leaf with light fading at the edges due to oxidation. This is a great Tie guan Yin, but not toasted.

Its liquor, depending on infusion time, varies between a clear green and green-yellowish. Very aromatic with floral and sweet notes, it is refreshing, sweet, clean and without astringency.

Black Pearl - Taiwan

12,00 €

Grown in the Tung Tai region in the East of Taiwan, this tea comes from those Oolong teas that are oxidized for a longer time, around 70%. Shiny amber in colour with an aromatic smell of tropical fruits produces an unforgettable sensation in the nose and mouth. A tea that will take you to paradise!
